

Cal Poly Recreation Center Guest Passes

Sponsored Day Guest Pass Use:

Current Cal Poly students and Recreation Center members may sponsor a guest. Students and members are allotted one sponsored guest over the age of 16 per visit. The guest and sponsor must both be present in order to purchase the day pass. The Recreation Center member and their guest are required to provide proof of eligibility (see below) purchase guest pass, and complete a Day Pass Waiver of Liability form at the Recreation Center front desk.

Day Use Passes	Price
Student Guest Daily Pass	\$5 with student ID card (college or high school ID)
Non-Student Guest Daily Pass	\$10

Eligible Recreation Center Members as guests:

Cal Poly alumni, faculty and staff, and retired and emeriti who do not currently have a Recreation Center membership may purchase a non-student guest daily pass *without* being sponsored. Proof of membership eligibility is required at the time of purchasing a guest day pass (i.e. Alumni Associate Member card or faculty/staff Cal Poly card)

Eligible Recreation Center members may apply one day guest pass to a NEW annual or 3 month membership by providing their receipt at the time of new membership purchase. The receipt must be redeemed within 30 days of the purchased day guest pass.

Recreation Center Tours for guests:

Guests may tour the facility without being sponsored and do not need to pay a day guest pass fee. An ASI staff member will gladly provide a guided tour every thirty minutes (on the 15 and 45 of the hour). Guests who request just a tour do not need to be sponsored by a current Cal Poly student or Recreation Center member.

Recreation Center Tours for large groups:

Age Agreement:

No children under the age of 16 will be allowed in the Recreation Center except during special authorized programming. Children 16 and older who are dependents of current Recreation Center members will be considered members during summer quarter only.
