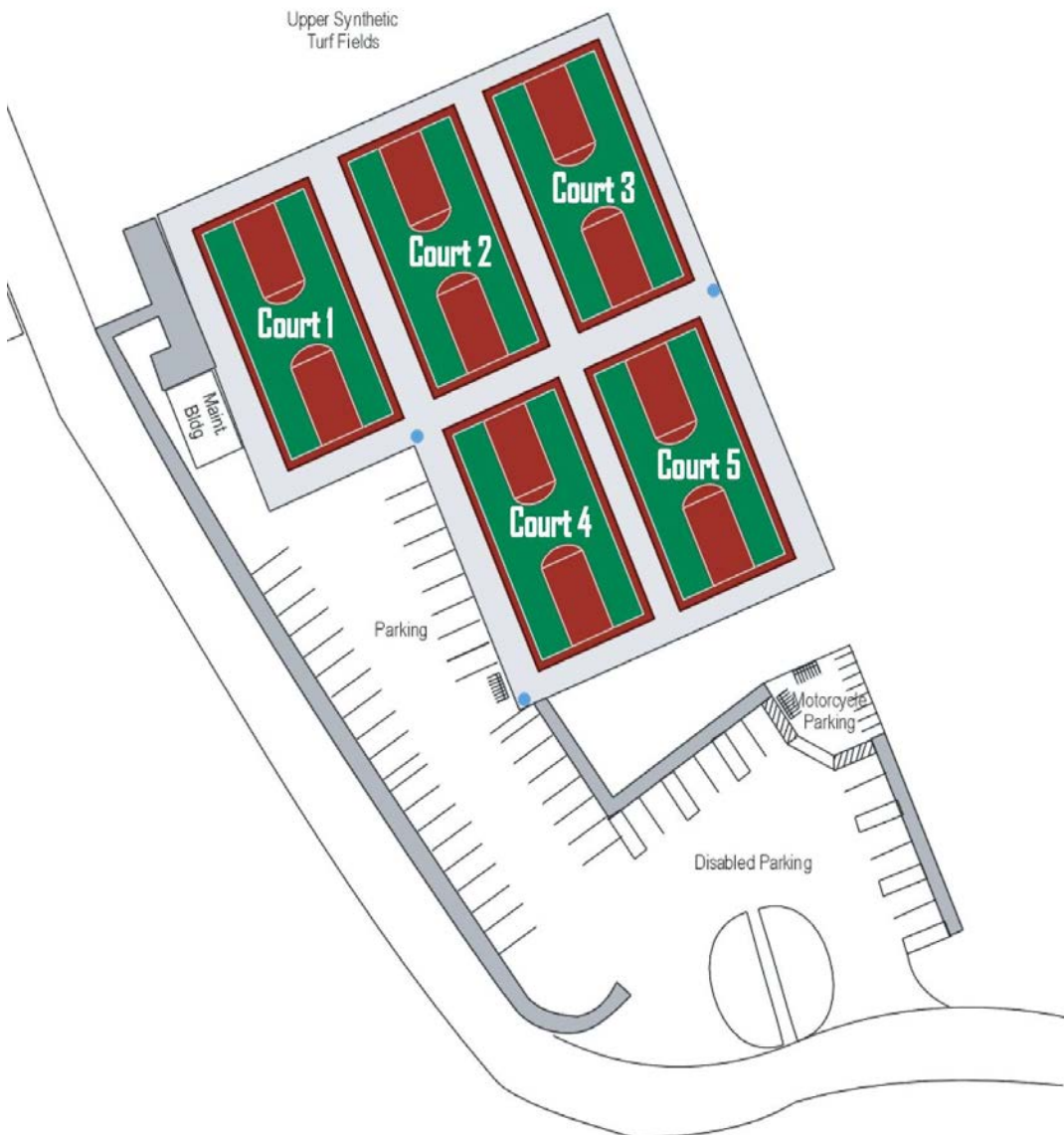


OUTDOOR BASKETBALL COURT POLICY

Facility

The Outdoor Basketball Courts consist of five lighted full size basketball courts located at the Upper Sports Complex, between the Synthetic Turf Fields and the stadiums.

The primary purpose of the Outdoor Basketball Courts is to provide a location for drop-in basketball that does not require a reservation or prior approval.



Facility Policy

Two of the five courts are permanently identified as Informal Recreation (Courts 4 &5) as that is the primary purpose of the facility.

Court Usage

Three of the courts (Courts 1-3) will be available for programmed activity:

Academic Courses

Monday-Friday during academic quarters from 10am-1pm for course use.

ASI Intramural Sports

One night of the week from 5pm-midnight for competitive league activities. The specific night of the week will be chosen by ASI on a quarter by quarter basis to maximize participation.

Scheduled Events

One weekend a month three courts may be reserved for events. A weekend event may cover Saturday and Sunday. These requests need to be processed through the normal facility reservation process for recreational facilities (see Reservation Procedures). The ASI Facility Scheduler will maintain the monthly event schedule and priority will be given on a first come first served basis.

Facility Reservations

(Courts 1-3 during above identified circumstances) Student Clubs initiate their requests through the Epicenter in the Julian A. McPhee University Union. For more information, please visit [Club Services¹](#) or call 756-5807.

Off Campus Groups must schedule their events through Conference and Event Planning. Their phone number is 756-7600.

Rainout Practice Option

During inclement weather the courts may be used to accommodate club sport practices who have been displaced from a field that is closed for play. An ASI Field Supervisor will make that determination as necessary to best meet the needs of displaced sport teams, and ensure that the sport activities are facility appropriate.

Facility Hours

The Outdoor Basketball Courts will be unlocked at all times and open for play even when there is no supervisor present. However, the ASI supervised hours (during the academic year) will be:

Staffed Hours

Sunday-Thursday: 8:30am-midnight

Friday: 8:30am-8pm

Saturday: 8:30am-8pm

**Summer Quarter and Quarter Breaks will not follow the established Staffed Hours. ASI will determine staffing for these times depending on usage patterns.*

The overhead lights for the basketball courts are manually operated but will go off at 11:45pm

Rental Rate

There will be no rental fee for clubs, student organizations, campus departments or any other on-campus users.

\$30/hour per court for off-campus groups (if reservations are processed through Conference Services).

Supervision Charges

The Sports Complex is staffed with one supervisor during "Staffed Hours". This oversight will meet the regularly scheduled activities at the facility.

If a campus event request (clubs, student organizations, campus departments or any other on-campus users) falls within the "Staffed Hours" and requires no additional supervision then there will be no fee to on-campus users.

Depending on the nature of an event request, additional supervision may be required. Determination of additional staffing needs will be made by ASI based on the information provided in the event request.

Supervision Fees:

Clubs, student organizations, campus departments or any other on-campus users.

If an event requires additional supervision, the rate will be \$15/hour for on-campus groups.

Off Campus users (if reservations are processed through Conference Services).

Conference Services activities will be billed at \$20/hour per staff member needed.

Non-Basketball Activities

ASI recognizes that the courts may occasionally be used for non-basketball activities. The following is a guide for potential uses that are beyond outdoor basketball. This list will be updated from time to time as needed.

Potential Non-basketball uses may include:

- Soccer (only ASI approved soccer goals)
- Dance and Cheer activity
- Dodgeball
- Whiffleball
- Approved club sport activities displaced by rain.
- Team building activities (Activity subject to approval)
- Non-sport activities that do not damage the court surface (Subject to ASI approval)

ASI has a desire to maintain the appearance and integrity of the basketball courts for many years. As a result the following activities will not be approved due to the damage they may cause the facility. This list will be updated from time to time as needed.

Unapproved uses of courts consists of:

- Roller Hockey
- Street Hockey
- Field Hockey
- Skateboarding
- Roller skating
- Roller blading
- Concerts (no amplified sound unless approved)
- Volleyball Nets for volleyball events
- Badminton Nets for badminton events
- Remote control devices
- Model rockets
- Fire or any open flame

OUTDOOR BASKETBALL COURT RULES

- No hanging from rims, nets, or goal supports
- No bikes, rollerblades, roller skates, or skate boards are allowed No hockey on the courts.
- No tables, chairs, or tents on the playing surface unless approved. No barbeques on the courts.
- No animals (except to assist persons of disability).
- No vehicles allowed on the court surface except for maintenance or emergency. No food or drink, except water, on the court surface.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- No glass containers on the court surface.
- No sunflower seeds, or gum on the court surface. No spitting on the courts or in the drinking fountains. No tobacco products allowed.
- No painting, chalking, tape or other adhesive material shall be placed on the court surface without prior approval.
- No attaching items to fence, light poles, or basketball goals. No use of personal sound systems.
- No fireworks or any open flame in the court area.
- Courts may be closed at any time due to safety related concerns.
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate cancellation of reservation.
