## Battle of the Bands 2016 Rules

1. Failure to adhere to ASI Services Agreement, policies and rules will result in disqualification.
2. The deadline for submitting the application is Sunday, February 28, 2016 by 8:00 p.m. to [ASI Concerts](#)<sup>1</sup>.
3. Music must be performed live; any prerecorded sets will result in disqualification.
4. Each band will have a 20 minute set. Sound will be cut after exactly 20 minutes.
5. Bands will have 15 minutes to set up and take down. Anything the band brings to the event must be able to be set up and taken down in 15 minutes.
6. ASI AV will provide only 4 monitor mixes. No more than 12 sound inputs will be available.
7. ASI will provide a drum kit day of competition.
8. Upon being selected for the competition, each band will be required to provide a stage plot, patch list and a list of equipment.
9. ASI paperwork given to selected bands for the competition must be completed and returned to ASI Events within 5 business days to avoid disqualification.
10. At least one of the band members must be a current Cal Poly student with a valid Cal Poly EmplID and email address.
11. A band will be selected based off of highest number of overall votes at the time of the performance. Only Cal Poly students with a valid Cal Poly email address will be allowed to vote. One voter may vote for as many bands as they would like.
12. The results will be compiled and determined by ASI Events staff. In the event of a tie, ASI Events Staff will make tie-breaker decision. All decisions made are final.
13. The winning band will receive opening set privileges on the main stage at Spring Stampede 2016.
14. On stage visuals are prohibited (but a band banner is OK).
15. No guests will be allowed backstage. Any person without an official name tag provided by ASI Events is not permitted to be with the band during the competition.
16. The band will be required to arrive two hours before the scheduled event to run a sound check and related procedures. The band will be disqualified from the competition if all members are not present at their sound check time.
17. Bands will not be allowed to sell merchandise.
18. ASI is not responsible for lost or stolen equipment.
19. ASI Events reserves the right to amend these rules at any time without notice.
20. At any point on the day of Spring Stampede 2016, ASI Events reserves the right to dismiss the winner from the venue for failure to comply with the rules listed here, ASI Policy and/or at the discretion of ASI Events.
