The Intramural Sports Program at Cal Poly strives to provide an inclusive environment for the Cal Poly community to participate in a variety of recreational sports, tournaments, and activities.

The purpose of the Intramural Sports Program is to offer a variety of structured leagues, sports, and tournaments in a safe, recreationally competitive environment. Intramural Sports are open to all Cal Poly students, alumni, faculty, and staff who are currently members of the Recreation Center.

LEVELS OF PLAY

To accommodate and satisfy a wide range of recreational participants, each sport is divided into divisions and gender leagues. We offer men's, women's, and co-recreational leagues. Co-Rec leagues consist of teams with both men and women playing a sport.
