ASI Intramural Sports are open to all Cal Poly students, alumni, faculty, and staff who are currently members of the Recreation Center.

LEVELS OF PLAY

To accommodate and satisfy a wide range of recreational participants, each sport is divided into divisions and gender leagues. We offer men's, women's, and co-recreational leagues. Co-Rec leagues consist of teams with both men and women playing a sport with modifications to the rules.
