

FAMILY FUN DAYS

GUEST PRICING AND GUIDELINES

During Family Fun Days, members may purchase guest passes for up to **two adults** and up to **six children** in accordance with a strict supervision ratio of two children (0-15 years) to one adult (16+ years). Guests must be accompanied by a current Recreation Center member and purchase their guest passes from the Membership Services desk.

2019 Dates

- Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, June 21–September 1, 2019

Eligibility

- Current Cal Poly Recreation Center members must accompany and may sponsor up to
 - 2 adults (16+ years)
 - 6 supervised children (0-15 years)
- Each adult may supervise up to 2 children
 - 1 adult = 2 children
 - 2 adults = 4 children
 - 3 adults = 6 children

Guidelines

- Participants have access to recreation facilities including the Leisure Pool, Climbing Park, basketball and racquetball courts, studios, and age dependent access to exercise rooms and weight equipment.
- Must have photo identification verifying age. If no identification is provided, guest is considered a child guest of 15 years.
- Guests 0-17 years require a parent/guardian signature on ASI waiver of liability.
- One-visit guest pass
 - Adult guest \$10/day
 - Child guest \$5/day
- Multi-visit passes (MVP) are valid Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays, June 21–Sept. 1, 2019.
 - Adult MVP \$120
 - Child MVP \$60

Guest Age and Accessible Areas

- Adults have full access to all facilities.
- Adults may check out special game kits and sport equipment from The Pro Shop.
- Children 0-15 years must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Children 12-15 years do not have access to the second floor.
- Children 0-11 years do not have access to exercise rooms, weight equipment, or the second floor.
- Children 6 years and older must use the gender appropriate locker/restroom. *All gender restrooms with no restrictions are available on the first floor (by the locker rooms) and on the pool deck.*

Leisure Pool

- Children 0-3 years must wear swim diapers (available for sale at The Pro Shop).
- Children who cannot swim must be within arm's reach of an adult.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices allowed.
- Water toys are encouraged.

ASI Poly Escapes Climbing Park

- Adults and children 3+ years may use the Climbing Park.
- Harnesses for adults and children are provided.
- Climbing shoes are provided for adult male size 5 and larger; street shoes are acceptable for smaller sizes.

Food

Water and small snacks are permitted. Snacks may only be consumed on the grass area surrounding the sand volleyball courts. Small coolers and lunch bags are permitted. No large ice chests.

Parking
