ASI Supports Electronic Voting via the Cal Poly Portal

- WHEREAS: Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) is the official voice of Cal Poly students, and
- WHEREAS: ASI has worked closely with Cal Poly Information Technology Services (ITS), along with Student Life and Leadership, to examine available systems of voting for student elections and referenda, and
- WHEREAS: In 2007 ASI passed Resolution 07-06, "ASI Supports Electronic Polling in Campuswide Elections and Referenda" which resolved that "ASI shall use a system of electronic voting for all campuswide elections and referenda," and
- WHEREAS: Resolution 07-06 also resolved that "ASI shall continue to investigate and evaluate the electronic voting technology available and its effectiveness for the Cal Poly campus," and
- WHEREAS: It is no longer economically feasible for ITS to setup designated electronic polling locations, and
- WHEREAS: The Cal Poly Portal is a secure internet site, accessible by Cal Poly students, which requires user authentication, and
- WHEREAS: Cal Poly students access the Cal Poly Portal from a variety of locations, both on and off campus.

RESOLVED: ASI shall use a system of electronic voting for all campuswide elections and referenda which shall be made available to all students via the Cal Poly Portal, and

FURTHERMORE

RESOLVED: This system shall provide students accessibility to voting from any location with internet accessibility, and

FURTHERMORE
BE IT

RESOLVED ASI shall continue to evaluate this electronic voting system and other available technologies.
