ASI Encourages the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) to Continue to Provide Extended Evening Transit Service for the Cal Poly Community

- WHEREAS: Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) Board of Directors is the official voice of Cal Poly students, and
- WHEREAS: Cal Poly students, staff, and faculty comprised approximately 60% (33,000) of the riders on SLO Transit's extended evening service during the fiscal year 2008, and
- WHEREAS: Cal Poly is the largest contributor of fare revenue to SLO Transit, providing \$322,000 annually, and
- WHEREAS: Extended hours was the most suggested improvement (78.5%) in a 2006 ASI Student Government survey of SLO Transit student riders, and
- WHEREAS: Students, faculty, and staff are on campus in the evenings for reasons such as classes, club meetings, events, and work, and
- WHEREAS: The service provides a safe and convenient way for students, faculty, and staff to travel at night, and
- WHEREAS: The service offers a financial alternative to the \$105 cost of an Annual Evening Parking Permit at Cal Poly.

RESOLVED: That the ASI Board of Directors encourages SLOCOG to continue to provide extended evening transit service for the Cal Poly Community.
