II. Officers

A. Chair

1. Shall be the President of ASI at Cal Poly
2. Shall run the SCLC meetings and work with subcommittee chairs
3. Shall provide an agenda and minutes for each meeting
4. Appoint subcommittee chairs in conjunction with the Chair

B. Vice Chair

1. Shall be the President of ASCC
2. Assume responsibility for Chair in his/her absence

III. Meetings

- A. Shall be held the third Thursday of each month annually, unless otherwise noted in annual calendar or at the discretion of the Chair.

IV. Sub-Committees

A. SLO Solutions Sub-Committee

1. Responsible for monitoring and providing input as a collaborative partnership to provide mediation services to resolve neighborhood and landlord/tenant disputes.

B. Community Relations Sub-Committee

1. Shall be responsible for coordinating community events, including Neighborhood Cooperation Week and Good Neighbor Day and SLO Night with Your Neighbor.
2. Coordinate a peer message campaign that addresses neighborhood issues including alcohol related concerns.
3. Work with student orientation programs at Cal Poly and Cuesta College to incorporate SCLC messaging.
4. Implement Statement of Hopes for the Community.

C. Special Events Sub-Committee

1. Shall be responsible for assisting with coordination of special events including Town Gown Conference and SCLC sponsored events.
2. Implement SCLC marketing plan for distribution of brochures.

V. Sub-Committee Chairs

A. Qualifications

1. Must be a student at Cuesta College or Cal Poly

B. Duties

1. Shall convene sub-committee meetings as needed
2. Shall execute duties of sub-committee as outlined in Section IV

VI. Sub-Committee Membership

A. Selection

1. Shall be appointed by SCLC Chair and Vice Chair in consultation with the committee.
