VI. Community Reports

A. ASI President – Kelly Griggs

Kelly reported that ASI is currently wrapping up the year and she is transitioning with Sarah Storelli as the next ASI President.

She stated that the University Presidential Search Committee will continue their search as the committee felt that the candidates did not fit the role as expected. She stated that Sarah Storelli will serve as the next student representative on the committee.

Deb commented on the newly implemented noise ordinance stating that the premise list has grown but overall it seems to be calmer and quieter. She stated that there is a decline in noise violations.

D. Residents for Quality Neighborhoods – Frank Kassak

Frank, RQN, reported that there were 157 noise violations, 77 DACS, and 20 citations issued in May, in comparison to 2009 at 331 noise violations, 168 DACS and 18 citations.

Kelly stated that because there was not enough voting members for quorum, the SCLC Effectiveness Proposal will be a discussion item only and will be voted on at the July 15 meeting.
