IN SUPPORT OF UU FEE REFERENDUM FOR UU FACILITY EXPANSION/RENOVATION

- WHEREAS: University Union Facilities are an integral part of the educational mission of a university, and
- WHEREAS: University Union Facilities support the institutional values of Cal Poly, creating opportunities to enhance student recruitment and retention, and reinforce the sense of campus community, and
- WHEREAS: A comprehensive UU Facilities Master Plan was completed in July 2004, and
- WHEREAS: A campuswide survey was conducted during spring quarter 2003 to determine the need for the expansion/renovation of UU facilities, and
- WHEREAS: 59% of the more than 5,000 students responding to this survey expressed a need for the expansion/renovation of existing UU facilities and a new facility located in the northwest area of campus, and
- WHEREAS: An additional campuswide survey was conducted during fall quarter 2004 to determine student interest in contributing a fee to pay for the expansion/renovation of UU facilities, and
- WHEREAS: 66% of the more than 4,400 students responding to this survey expressed support of pursuing the project and willingness to pay an additional fee to fund the expansion/renovation of UU facilities on campus.
