ASI URGES INCREASED COLLABORATION BETWEEN
CAMPUS ENTITIES AND CAL POLY STUDENTS

WHEREAS: Associated Students Incorporated is the official voice of the Cal Poly student body, and

WHEREAS: 11% of Cal Poly undergraduate students are members of the Greek community, and

WHEREAS: Housing and Residential Life distributed a pamphlet to all on-campus residents on September 10th, 2005 with the consequence of dissuading Cal Poly students from becoming a part of the Greek community, and

WHEREAS: The pamphlet cited data based on outdated national statistics which do not accurately reflect the Greek community of Cal Poly, and

WHEREAS: Housing and Residential Life did not consult the Greek community about these statistics, and

WHEREAS: Housing and Residential Life did not collaborate with the directly-affected Greek community when producing and distributing the pamphlet, and

WHEREAS: ASI recognizes the importance of students being actively involved in the decisions that directly affect the students of Cal Poly, and

RESOLVED: ASI strongly encourages Housing & Residential Life to work cooperatively with the Greek community to remediate the damages caused by the distribution of this pamphlet and to prevent reoccurrences of such incidents, and

RESOLVED: ASI expects all Cal Poly entities to collaborate professionally and to work together with all affected parties when taking actions or displaying statistics which directly affect members of the university community.
