ASI ENCOURAGES INCREASED SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS PROGRAMMING IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS

- WHEREAS: Associated Students Incorporated is the official voice of the Cal Poly student body, and
- WHEREAS: ASI encourages student success by advocating for student safety using all reasonable means, and
- WHEREAS: ASI is committed to Resolutions #04-12 and #5-11 which promote safety and gender equity, and
- WHEREAS: Campus organizations such as the Women's Center, SAFER, UPD, and SAFE Organizations pledge to support sexual assault awareness and student safety, and
- WHEREAS: Female college freshmen within the first thirty days of school are at the highest risk of sexual assault, and
- WHEREAS: Housing and Residential Life provides a living and learning experience for over 2,500 freshmen on campus, and
- WHEREAS: Housing and Residential Life is uniquely positioned to reach a captive audience of freshmen, and
- WHEREAS: Housing and Residential Life currently promotes but does not actively engage students in sexual assault prevention in the residence halls, and
- WHEREAS: The effectiveness of sexual assault awareness programming can be greatly enhanced by collective efforts of all campus entities to recognize the problem of sexual assault and work together to encourage attendance and participation by all campus and community stakeholders.

- RESOLVED: ASI encourages active sexual assault awareness and prevention programming in the all of the residence halls targeting all residents within the first quarter of the school year, and

- RESOLVED: ASI encourages a collaboration between all campus entities, including UPD, SAFER, SAFE Organizations, Housing and Residential Life, and ASI in order to reach the maximum number of residents possible.
