Matt would like to conduct some sort of assessment of Student Government. He explained the ASI Assessment Committee and would like to apply their processes. It could involve polling students and staff, on-site surveys, email requests, etc. He will be developing this idea and keeping UUAB posted. Suggestions and ideas are welcome.

Brailsford and Dunlavey will be on campus again on March 11 and will attend the UUAB meeting. They will be updating ASI on their progress.

An outdoor concert is being considered for August 13th on the upper fields of the Sports Complex. Jack Johnson and Ben Harper are available on that date. Even though it is during summer quarter, the draw of these two headliners should be enough to test out Cal Poly's capability for this type of event.

The budget process has begun and Matt will keep everyone posted as to timelines and meetings. Renee will be the UUAB representative to Board of Director's Budget Committee.

Sharon Potter reported that she attended the first Collegiate Sports Program Task Force meeting today. This group was formed to look at the on-going problem of clubs and teams that are operating without any support from Cal Poly. There is no more room in the intramural program or in the sports team program. The challenge of the task force is to look for answers to this problem.

MEMBER REPORTS

- A. Jake Parnell announced that the Board of Director's approved the hiring of an additional Program Coordinator in the UU Epicenter. The focus of this position, to begin with, will be club services. Sharon Potter will be a member of the search committee, which will begin reviewing applications in April. The start date is July 1, 2003.

- B. Mark Hunter reported that the second phase of the new science building should start in December.

The playground equipment at the Children's Center is being replaced.

The fountain project has been approved and will be started during the summer.

- C. Marcy Maloney reported that the Assistant Directors met last week to discuss the use of the Rec Center for more events. Next year, fewer intramural teams will be allowed to allow more time slots for concerts, etc. in the Rec Center. There will be constant assessment of this plan.

- D. Stephen Harvey from Board of Directors reported:

- a. Parking issues are on the next agenda. There are several ideas being considered.
- b. The anti-smoking campaign to ban smoking for the entire campus is being pushed by a group called COUGH (Campuses Organized and United for Good Health). Their proposal will be presented to President Baker in the near future.
- c. About 40 students representing Cal Poly attended the CSSA CHESS conference in Sacramento last weekend to lobby against the budget cuts imposed by the Governor. They made it clear that Cal Poly students were willing to work harder and pay extra for a good education, unlike most of the other schools there, who demanded no further fee hikes.
